

LPN (Per Diem) –

Schedule: 4pm-12am Monday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

- Performs nursing services, which include vital signs, and the administration of all medications and treatments as ordered, and in accordance with accepted standards of clinical practice.
- Complete medical forms, reports, evaluations, studies, charting as necessary.
- Participates in inspections made by authorized government agencies.
- Assists the Quality Assessment & Assurance Committee in developing and implementing appropriate plans of action.
- Assist patients, family members or other clients with concern and empathy; respect their confidentiality and privacy and communicate with them in a courteous and respectful manner.
- Answer and refer telephone calls or other inquires to ensure accurate and timely communications are facilitated.
- Assigns/directs nurse aids to specific jobs related to the resident's individualized plan to ensure quality resident services.
- Documents the specifics of all personnel incidents on designated forms and submit this report within 24 hours.
- Keeps the medical team informed of observations and changing conditions of residents.

Requirements:

- Must be a graduate of an approved school for practical or vocational nursing.
- Must possess a current, valid LPN license in New Jersey.
- Must be prompt, dependable, honest, patient, caring and willing to work under supervision.
- Must be able to multi-task and be highly organized with strong attention to detail.
- Experience in long term care setting preferred.
